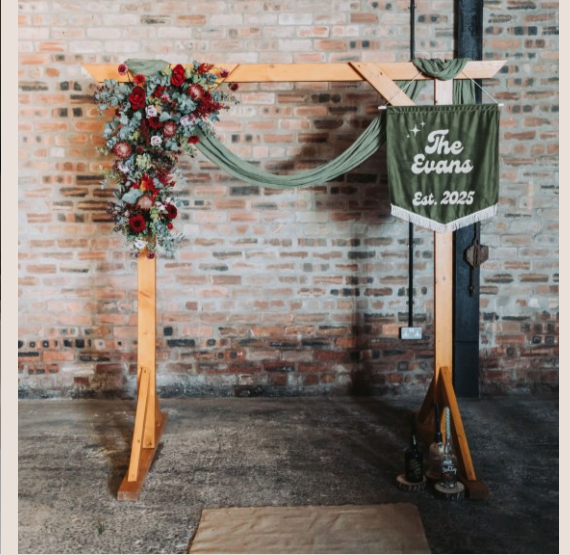
Our stationery is design led, printed on some of the finest cardstocks and finished with pretty details. As for our flowers, you could describe them as relaxed, textural and for the free at heart.

How we work

Stationery



- We begin with an initial consultation, either in person or via Zoom.
- You can view samples and we will discuss your ideas and stationery requirements.
- A quote will be provided, followed by a sample where applicable.
- Amendments can be made at this stage prior to approval.
- To secure your booking, a 75% deposit and signed contract are required.
- We will be in touch around one month before your items are due to go to print to finalise the details.
- The remaining balance is payable before the final items are sent to print.

Flowers



- We start with an initial consultation, either in person or via Zoom.
- We will discuss your ideas, style and floral requirements.
- A personalised quote will then be provided.
- To secure your booking, we require the higher of £150 or 25% of the quoted total, along with a signed contract.
- A final planning call will be arranged around one month before the wedding to confirm the details.
- The remaining balance is due one month prior to the wedding.

Bouquet Preservation



- Bouquet preservation is an optional add on service, primarily for couples whose wedding flowers are supplied by Paper & Petals, with limited availability for other enquiries.
- A £100 deposit and completed booking form are required to secure your booking.
- The remaining balance is due one month prior to the wedding.
- Bouquets must be dropped off in person in the days immediately following the wedding.
- Drying takes around four to six weeks, with the full preservation process typically taking three to five months.

Guide Pricing

The pricing outlined below is designed to offer a considered guide, helping you understand how your stationery and floral designs may come together, rather than a list to be totalled. Each wedding we create is entirely bespoke, with costs shaped by your overall vision and the scale of your day.

For our floral work, we typically partner with couples investing in the region of £1,000 to £2,000+. This level of investment allows for a beautifully cohesive look across the bridal party, alongside thoughtfully designed ceremony and table arrangements. Where availability allows, we are also pleased to accommodate smaller commissions, such as bridal party flowers.

Delivery and on-site setup are quoted separately for our floral work, allowing us to tailor the level of service required for your venue, logistics and styling. This ensures everything is carefully installed and finished exactly as envisioned on the day.

If you feel we might be the right fit for your day, we would be delighted to hear more about your plans and create a proposal tailored to you.

Q&A

Q. What types of stationery do you offer?

A. Bespoke, modern and design led wedding stationery. We provide save the dates, invitations, table plans, table names, place cards, menus, order of service and signage

Q. When do you arrange and send stationery?

A. Save the dates are usually sent 12 - 18 months before, invitations 3-4 months and on the day stationery 1 month before. Most couples speak to us around 9-12 months in advance of their wedding to design their suite.

Q. What type of flowers do you offer and are they real or artificial?

A. Natural, textural and laid back fresh and dried wedding flowers. We provide bouquets, buttonholes, corsages, table centrepieces, archway flowers, thank you bouquets, cake flowers and more.

Q. When do we need to book flowers?

A. There really is no time as “too soon” especially if you wedding is in or around summer.

Q. Can we only book you if we need both stationery and flowers?

A. Not at all. You are welcome to book either service on its own. Many couples do choose to book both, as it allows us to fully understand their vision and carry it through seamlessly from stationery to flowers on the wedding day. Working with one trusted supplier can also save time and provide peace of mind, knowing everything has been thoughtfully coordinated.

Q. When do we need to book in for Bouquet Preservation?

A. Bouquet preservation should be booked in advance of the wedding to ensure availability. Although the preservation process takes place after the day itself, we need to receive your bouquet in the days immediately following your wedding for the best possible results. We recommend booking as early as possible to secure your place in our preservation schedule.
